

A TOP DESTINATION

OFFERING FAMILY FUN FOR EVERYONE

Touted by *Southern Living* as one of America's top family weekend getaways and by *Disney Family Fun* magazine as one of the best vacation destinations in the country, Chattanooga is a hotspot for family fun and entertainment. In 2010, more than three million people visited Chattanooga, generating over \$750 million in tourism revenue.

Popular attractions have drawn tourists to the Chattanooga area for decades. Some of the most recognized and enjoyed downtown attractions include the Tennessee Aquarium, which features the largest freshwater aquarium in the world, and the IMAX theatre. Also located in the city are the Chattanooga Choo Choo, a historic hotel with concert venues and restaurants, and the Tennessee Valley Railroad Museum, a moving museum stationed aboard an old-fashioned train.

Nearby Lookout Mountain features Ruby Falls, the nation's largest and deepest waterfall open to the public; Rock City, a 4,100-foot walking trail showcasing towering rock formations, caves and lush gardens; and the Incline Railway, the steepest passenger railway in the world.

Outdoor family activities include the Chattanooga Zoo, Lake Winnesepesaukah and the Chattanooga Market where visitors and residents can enjoy food, crafts and entertainment from around the region. Tours provide delightful views and helpful information about the city and its surrounding areas.

Downtown tour options include double decker buses, Funny Cars, horse trams, duck boats and pedicabs, as well as riverboat cruises that sail along the Tennessee River.

Meanwhile, sports fans can enjoy a wide variety of spectator entertainment options. In the summer, baseball fans can cheer on the Chattanooga Lookouts, a AA minor league baseball affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, and join fellow enthusiasts in supporting the Chattanooga Football Club, the area's professional soccer team. In the fall, local residents gather at University of Tennessee at Chattanooga Mocs football and basketball games, where both teams compete in the NCAA Division 1.

Public and private tennis and golf facilities are also located throughout the area. One of Chattanooga's most prized golf courses, the Honors Course, has hosted amateur tournaments including the USGA Men's Amateur and Mid-Amateur Championships, Curtis Cup matches and the NCAA Men's Division I Championship. A favorite for competitive tennis, the Manker Patten Tennis Club has received the USTA Outstanding Facility of the Year award.

From famous attractions to traditional family fun, Chattanooga is one of the country's most popular cities for fun and entertainment.
